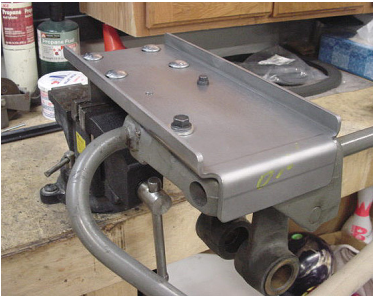

## Lift Rods Bench Mount

Part No. **PPP-LRBM**



For best results use in 5" (or larger) bench vise. Minimum advisable bench vise size 4".

Always use high grade mounting bolts and lubricate threads with lightweight oil to extend service life and smooth operation.

Always use thru-hard washers (included) under bolt to prevent galling of slotted mounting hole.



Remove clapper box height adjusting screw and firmly secure lift rods assembly under Lift Rods Bench Mount with provided (located above slotted hole) grade 8 bolt and thru-hard washer. Secure Lift Rods Bench Mount flanges, with mounted lift rods assembly, squarely into bench vise.

The coupling-nut secured bolt is a lean-post to prevent lift rods from pivoting during gum rubber installation. This bolt (and washers) are grade 8 and may be substituted for lost tool mounting hardware.

To service clapper box components, secure flanges to opposite side of tool.

After removing lift rods assembly from Lift Rods Bench Mount, return mounting bolt and washer into threaded hole to prevent their loss.
