TECHNICAL NOTE			
Please thoroughly read the instructions prior to performing the installation of this assembly. To avoid any potential problems, if at any time during the process you have a question, stop and contact our Tech Support department at the numbers listed below.			

STEPS

- 1. Lay the machine down in the operating position and disconnect the power from machine.
- 2. Unplug the existing battery charger cords and remove charger & plate from the machine.
- 3. Remove old charger from the charger plate.
- Position the template supplied on top of the plate and using a drill w/ 11/64" bit, drill four new holes into the charger plate as indicated on the template.



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- 5. Position the 154-6417-2911 Battery Charger Plate on the bench so the "U" shaped cut-out is towards the left, w/ the (2) .171" holes on the center of the edge of the long side of the plate towards you.
- 6. Lay the 158-8470 ProTech Battery Charger on the plate so the end w/ the power cord plug is toward the left. Line the (4) mounting holes in the charger up w/ the mounting holes in the plate.
- Place a 153-2002 #8 Flat Washer on each of the (4) 153-2086 8-32 x 5/8" MS. Push two of the screws up through the holes in the backside of the plate & the charger mounting slots. Secure on the topside w/ another 8-32 Flat Washer & a 153-2019 8-32 Locknut. Tighten screws completely.
- 8. Run the black cable plugged into the left side of the charger along the long edge of the plate closest to you. Slide both 153-1049E 3/8" Harness Clamps onto the cable, lobes upward & towards you. Push 2 more of the 8-32 MS through the two front holes, the slots in the charger, then through the 3/8" harness clamps. Secure on the topside w/ another #8 Flat Washer & 8-32 Locknuts. Tighten screws completely.
- 9. Re-install the charger plate assy back into the machine
- 10. Plug the charger cables back into the harness cables.
- 11.Plug machine into the wall outlet and using a voltmeter, check new charger for proper output voltage.
